Order No. 2703/2018

Re: Appointment of the National OECD GLP Compliance Monitoring Authority to the
Bureau of Laboratory Quality Standards

This order refers to the resolution of the National Standardization Council (NSC) in its meeting No. 8-1/2018 on 27 August 2018 which appointed the Department of Medical Sciences to act as the National OECD GLP Compliance Monitoring Authority with the duties for inspecting and monitoring the OECD GLP Laboratory Compliance covering the scopes of 1) pharmaceuticals, 2) pesticides, 3) cosmetic products, 4) veterinary drugs, 5) food additives, 6) feed additives, 7) industrial chemicals and others (to be added or amended).

In order that the work operation according to the resolution can be conducted effectively, the Director General of the Department of Medical Sciences has issued this order according to the Article No. 31 and No. 32 of the National Administration Act, B.E. 2534 (A.D. 1991) as follows:

1. Appoint the Bureau of Laboratory Quality Standards to act as the National OECD GLP Compliance Monitoring Authority in the scopes assigned to the Department of Medical Sciences in the resolution.

2. The duties of the Bureau of Laboratory Quality Standards are as follows:

2.1 Perform the inspection according to the OECD GLP and registration of the test facilities.

2.2 Develop and prepare the regulation conditions and procedures for the inspection of the test facilities.

2.3 Develop the capabilities of the inspectors and personnel of the National OECD GLP CMA Office.

2.4 Report on the progress in the development of the plan to promote the competitiveness of the commercial products for the non-clinical safety testing according to the OECD GLP to the National Standardization Council (NSC).

2.5 Coordinate with the Receiving Authorities in the registration of the Thai products such as the Department of Agriculture, etc.

2.6 Coordinate with the other international organizations which belong to the OECD GLP member countries.

This order is effective immediately.
